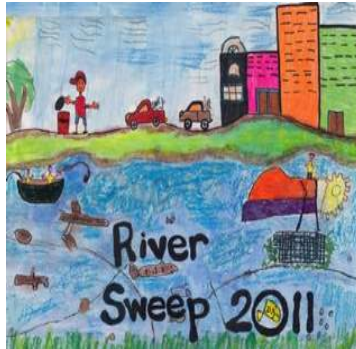


Volunteers Needed for Ohio River Sweep!

Who: Civic organizations, scout troops, clubs, families, and individuals are encouraged to participate. Minors need to have parental permission forms signed in advance. How: Registration opens at 9 a.m. at the Falls of the Ohio State Park, Ashland Park, George Rogers Clark Park, and Lapping Park. Gloves, trash bags, and water will be provided and you can choose the area in which you'd like to make a difference. Volunteers receive a free tee shirt and free admission to the Falls of the Ohio Interpretive Center all day! Come on out and show your community spirit!
